REPORT OF FOREST AND WINDBARRIER PLANTING IN THE UNITED STATES

(July 1, 1959 - June 30, 1960)

Acres Planted--Fiscal Year 1960 and Previous Years

Tree planting during the fiscal year 1960 (July 1, 1959 - June 30, 1960) as reported by various public agencies, principally the State Foresters, was as follows:

Tree planting continued at a high level but failed to show an increase over the previous year for the first time in 9 years. The 2,137,460 acres planted is more than double the acreage planted in 1956. Forest plantings show a decrease of 16,377 acres while windbarrier plantings show an increase of 2,094 acres for a net decrease of 14,283 acres or two-thirds of one percent. Tree planting on land withdrawn from agricultural production through Conservation Reserve Soil Bank contracts again is responsible for a large part of the acreage planted in 1960 in excess of that planted in 1956.

Comparison of the 1960 with the 1959 figures shows changes in planting activity by the three broad ownership classes as follows:

The <u>Federal Government</u> planted 173,486 acres of forest and 1,007 acres of windbarriers in 1960 on lands administered by its various agencies; a total of 174,493 acres. This is 5,326 acres or 3 percent more than in 1959. (Federal windbarrier planting decreased 550 acres.)

The <u>States and other non-Federal public agencies</u> planted 91,216 acres of forest and 115 acres of windbarriers; a total of 91,331 acres. This is 24,473 acres or 37 percent more than in 1959. This increase is due largely to a substantial increase in planting on State forest land in Michigan and Oregon. (Windbarrier plantings on State lands increased 47 acres.)

<u>Private landowners</u> planted 1,837,392 acres of forest and 34,244 acres of windbarriers, a total of 1,871,636 acres. This is 44,082 acres or 2.3 percent less than in 1959. (Private windbarrier plantings increased 2,597 acres.)

A further analysis of the above figures shows that forest planting on forest industry and other industry land increased substantially, whereas forest planting on privately-owned land in smaller holdings decreased a total of 169,255 acres, or 12.2 percent.

Eighty-seven percent of all forest planting is on privately-owned lands. The 17 States with forest plantings of over 20,000 acres on privately-owned land are listed below. This listing also includes the 14 States with more than 10,000 acres of planting on industry-owned land. It should be noted that more than 50 percent of private land forest planting in three of these 17 States is on industry-owned land. These States are Oregon with 88.5%, Washington with 75.9%, and Louisiana with 61.8%.

One-third of the private forest planting in 1960 was on land owned by industrial organizations compared to one-quarter in 1959. In 1960 forest industries planted 520,150 acres, 103,044 acres more than in 1959; and other industries planted 96,529 acres, 19,532 more than in 1959.

<u>Windbarrier Planting</u>

Windbarrier planting was reported from 29 States and Puerto Rico. It amounted to 35,366 acres, classed as follows:

Private land windbarrier planting increased 2,597 acres in 1960. The public agencies planted 503 acres less than in 1959. The overall result is an increase of 6.3 percent from the previous year.

The need for windbarriers exists mostly on private lands. The States in which farmers and ranchers planted 500 or more acres of windbarrier in 1960 are:

In 1960, the 15 <u>Federal nurseries</u> shipped 177,698,000 trees in comparison with 169,473,000 in 1959. Most of the Forest Service nursery trees were planted on national forest lands. Nursery stock from the Tennessee Valley Authority nurseries was used on private lands through established programs.

The <u>State nurseries</u> shipped 1,359,306,000 plants in 1960. Most of the stock from these nurseries was produced under the Federal-State cooperative tree distribution program (C-M 4) or the Conservation Reserve of the Soil Bank for planting on private lands. These 10 States shipped 57 percent of the Nation's entire supply.

Forty-three States and Puerto Rico shipped 1,359,306,000 trees from 108 nurseries in 1960. In 1959, 104 nurseries shipped 1,536,694,000 plants. This net increase of four nurseries resulted from adding seven new ones (Colorado, Georgia, Louisiana, Maine, Michigan, South Carolina, and South Dakota), subtracting one closed nursery (Michigan), and two with no shipments in 1960 (Georgia and Rhode Island). Not included in this figure of 108 shippers are four that shipped no trees in 1960 and four game food and cover plant nurseries.

Forty-eight States and Puerto Rico conducted tree distribution programs in 1960. Five of these purchased all of the trees they distributed from commercial, other State, or Federal nurseries. Arizona and Alaska are the only two States that did not distribute trees in 1960.

The total output of the 11 <u>Soil Conservation District nurseries</u> was 13,262,000 trees as against 13,571,000 for the 11 nurseries in 1959. The stock from these nurseries all goes to District cooperators for planting on private lands.

There are now 4 <u>county and municipal nurseries</u>. They produced 558,000 trees in 1960 as against 572,000 from five nurseries in 1959. Their entire output is planted on public lands.

Most seedlings from <u>forest industry and land company nurseries</u> go to plant company lands, although some stock is distributed to other private

landowners through various company programs. There continues to be 34 such nurseries with an output of 258,810,000 trees as against an output of 244,384,000 trees in 1959. Three companies closed one nursery each, three new nurseries shipped trees for the first time in 1960, and one additional company nursery expects to ship its first crop in 1961.

Commercial nurseries reporting in 1960 numbered 80 and their total output was 109,112,000 plants, which is 5 percent less than in 1959. No commercial production of forest or windbarrier planting stock is reported from 28 States and Puerto Rico.

of the 80 commercial nurseries that reported, 17 are in Pennsylvania and 25 are in Michigan. Their production runs heavily to Christmas tree planting stock. Sixteen commercial nurseries reported from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Nebraska, and the two Dakotas. They produce mainly windbarrier species in addition to much ornamental stock not reported herein. A large share of their production is sold to the States for distribution under the Federal-State cooperative tree planting program. The other 22 commercial nurseries are located in 14 States distributed from coast to coast, primarily in the North.

Direct Seeding

The reported acreage of direct sowing of tree seeds increased substantially in 1960. Twenty-seven States and Puerto Rico reported from 1 to 62,765 acres. The amount of such work is detailed in footnotes to Tables 1, 2, and 3 of this report and is summarized below:
