The 394,091 acre reduction in tree planting from last year's figure of 1796,206 acres was due in part to the substantial reduction in planting on land withdrawn from agricultural production through Conservation Reserve Soil Bank contracts. The 1,402,115 acres planted in 1962 includes mall acreage of Soil Bank planting or replanting. Soil Bank planting was of major importance for the fiscal years 1958 through 1961 but of little significance in 1962.

***This does not represent the area satisfactorily reforested or established to windbarriers, for some of the plantings or seedings are unsuccessful. It is estimated that 80 percent of this acreage will result in acceptable plantations.

The total amount of planting in each State is shown by class of owners and purpose in Table 6 of this report. More than 50,000 acres were planted in 1962 in each of the following 9 States:

Comparison of the 1962 with the 1961 figures shows changes in planting activity by the three broad ownership classes as follows:

<u>The Federal Government</u> planted 249,543 acres of forest and 480 acres of windbarriers in 1962 on lands administered by its various agencies; a total of 250,023 acres. This is 45,321 acres or 22.1 percent more than in 1961. (Federal windbarrier planting decreased 220 acres.)

The <u>States and other non-Federal public agencies</u> planted 100,660 acres of forest and 311 acres of windbarriers; a total of 100,971 acres. This is 1,285 acres or 1.3 percent less than in 1961. (Windbarrier plantings increased 190 acres.)

<u>Private landowners</u> planted 1,017,244 acres of forest and 33,877 acres of windbarriers; a total of 1,051,121 acres. This is 438,037 acres or 29.4 percent less than in 1961. (Private windbarrier plantings increased 527 acres.) Seventy-four percent of all forest planting was on privately-owned lands. The 16 States with forest plantings of over 20,000 acres on privatelyowned land are listed below. This listing also includes the 13 States with more than 10,000 acres of planting on industry-owned land. It should be noted that more than 50 percent of private land forest planting in 10 of these 16 States is on industry-owned land. These States are Washington with 91%, Oregon with 90%, Louisiana with 77%, Florida with 71%, Alabama with 61%, Texas with 59%, Virginia with 55%, Tennessee with 54%, Pennsylvania with 53% and North Carolina with 53%.

Nearly 50.5 percent of the private forest planting in 1962 was on land owned by industrial organizations compared to 46 percent in 1961. In 1962 forest industries planted 443,358 acres, 145,805 less than in 1961; and other industries planted 70,032 acres, 8,720 acres less than in 1961.

<u>Windbarrier Planting</u>

Windbarrier planting was reported from 28 States and Puerto Rico. It amounted to 34,668 acres, classed as follows:

Private land windbarrier planting increased 527 acres in 1962. The public agencies planted 30 acres less than in 1961. The overall result is an increase of 1.5 percent from the previous year.

The need for windbarriers exists mostly on private lands. The States in which farmers and ranchers planted 500 or more acres of windbarrier in 1962 are:

Sources of Planting Stock

All public and private nurseries together shipped 1,125,331,000 trees in 1962 -- 27 percent less than in 1961.

For additional details see Table 7 of this report and also "Forest Tree Nurseries in the United States - 1962," published by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, Washington, D.C. In 1962 the 16 <u>Federal</u> nurseries shipped 130,172,000 trees in comparison with 130,140,000 in 1961. Most of the Forest Service nursery trees were planted on National Forest lands. Planting stock from the Tennessee Valley Authority nursery was used on private lands through established pro grams.

The <u>State nurseries</u> shipped 722,744,000 plants in 1962. Most of the stock from these nurseries was produced under the Federal-State cooperative tree distribution program (C-M 4) or the Conservation Reserve of the Soil Bank for planting on private lands. The 10 States with the largest shipments were:

These 10 States shipped 45 percent of the Nation's entire supply.

Forty-three States and Puerto Rico shipped 722,744,000 trees from 99 nurseries in 1962. In 1961, 103 nurseries shipped 1,001,103,000 plants.

Forty-eight States and Puerto Rico conducted tree distribution programs in 1962. Five of these purchased all of the trees they distributed from commercial, other State, or Federal nurseries. Arizona and Alaska are the only two States that did not distribute trees in 1962.

The total output of the 9 <u>Soil Conservation District nurseries</u> was 11,521,000 trees as against 13,074,000 for the 11 nurseries in 1961. The stock from these nurseries all goes to District cooperators for planting on private lands.

There are now 3 <u>county and municipal nurseries</u>. They produced 639,000 trees in 1962 as against 479,000 from three nurseries in 1961. Their entire output is planted on public lands.

Most seedlings from <u>forest industry and land company nurseries</u> go to plant company lands, although some stock is distributed to other private landowners through various company programs. There were 29 such nurseries in 1962 with an output of 191,182,000 trees as against an output of 295,755,000 trees in 1961.

<u>Commercial nurseries</u> shipping stock in 1962 numbered 96 and their total output was 69,073,000 plants, which is 29 percent less than in 1961.

Of the 96 commercial nurseries that reported, 26 are in Pennsylvania and 25 are in Michigan. Their production runs heavily to Christmas tree planting stock. Twelve commercial nurseries reported from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Nebraska, and the two Dakotas. They produce mainly windbarrier species in addition to much ornamental stock not reported herein. A large share of their production is sold to the States for distribution under the Federal-State cooperative tree planting program. The other 33 commercial nurseries are located in 15 States distributed from coast to coast, primarily in the North. No commercial production of forest or windbarrier planting stock is reported from 27 States and Puerto Rico.

Direct Seeding

The reported acreage of direct sowing of tree seeds increased substantially in 1962. Thirty-six States reported from 6 to 76,214 acres. The amount of such work is detailed in Table 4 of this report and is summarized below:
