REPORT OF FOREST AND WINDBARRIER PLANTING AND SEEDING IN THE UNITED STATES

(July 1, 1962 - June 30, 1963)

Acres Planted - FY 1963 and Previous Years

Tree planting during the fiscal year 1963 (July 1, 1962 - June 30, 1963) as reported by various public agencies, principally the State Foresters, was as follows:

This represents a 39,416 acre reduction in tree planting from last year's figure of 1,402,115 acres.

***This does not represent the area satisfactorily reforested or established to windbarriers, for some of the plantings or seedings are unsuccessful. It is estimated that 80 percent of this acreage will result in acceptable plantations.

Comparison of the 1963 with the 1962 figures shows changes in planting activity by the three broad ownership classes as follows:

<u>The Federal Government</u> planted 268,490 acres of forest and 766 acres of windbarriers in 1963 on lands administered by its various agencies; a total of 269,256 acres. This is 19,233 acres or 7 percent more than in 1962. (Federal windbarrier planting increased 286 acres.)

The <u>States and other non-Federal public agencies</u> planted 103,623 acres of forest and 454 acres of windbarriers; a total of 104,077 acres. This is 3,106 acres or 3 percent more than in 1962. (Windbarrier plantings increased 143 acres.)

<u>Private landowners</u> planted 954,571 acres of forest and 34,791 acres of windbarriers; a total of 989,362 acres. This is 61,759 acres or 6 percent less than in 1962. (Private windbarrier plantings increased 914 acres.)

Tree Planters' Notes No. 62

Seventy-nine percent of all forest planting was on privately-owned lands. The 13 States with forest plantings of over 20,000 acres on privately-owned land are listed below. This listing also includes the 12 States with more than 10,000 acres of planting on industryowned land. More than 50 percent of the private land forest planting in 9 of these 13 States is on industry-owned land. These States are Oregon with 91%, Louisiana with 84%, Florida and Texas with 77%, Alabama and Georgia with 65%, North Carolina with 63%, Virginia with 61% and Pennsylvania with 52%.

About 56 percent of the private forest planting in 1963 was on land owned by industrial organizations compared to 50 percent in 1962. In 1963 forest industries planted 467,331 acres, 23,973 more than in 1962; and other industries planted 70,375 acres, 343 acres more than in 1962. Windbarrier Planting

Windbarrier planting was reported from 30 States and Puerto Rico. It amounted to 36,011 acres, classed as follows:

Private land windbarrier planting increased 914 acres in 1963. The public agencies planted 429 acres more than in 1962. The overall increase is 3.7 percent from the previous year.

For additional details see Table 7 of this report and also "Forest Tree Nurseries in the United States - 1963," Tree Planters' Notes #63 published by the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, Washington, D. C.,20250. In 1963 the 16 <u>Federal nurseries</u> shipped 126,592,000 trees in comparison with 130,172,000 in 1962. Most of the Forest Service nursery trees were planted on National Forest lands. Planting stock from the Tennessee Valley Authority nursery was used on private lands through established programs.

The <u>State nurseries</u> shipped 618,254,000 plants in 1963. Most of the stock from these nurseries was produced under the Federal-State cooperative tree distribution program (C-M 4). The 12 States with the largest shipments were:

These 12 States shipped 46 percent of the Nation's entire supply and 75 percent of the shipments from State nurseries.

Forty-three States and Puerto Rico shipped 618,254,000 trees from 99 nurseries in 1963. In 1962, 99 nurseries shipped 722,744,000 plants.

Forty-eight States and Puerto Rico conducted tree distribution programs in 1963. Five of these purchased all of the trees they distributed from commercial, other State, or Federal nurseries. Arizona and Alaska are the only two States that did not distribute trees in 1963. The total output of the 10 <u>Soil Conservation District nurseries</u> was 12,671,000 trees as against 11,521,000 for the 9 nurseries in 1962. The stock from these nurseries all goes to District cooperators for planting on private lands.

There are now 3 <u>county and municipal nurseries</u>. They produced 496,000 trees in 1963 as against 639,000 in 1962. Their entire output is planted in public lands.

Most seedlings from <u>forest industry and land company nurseries</u> go to plant company lands, although some stock is distributed to other private landowners through various company programs. A total of 26 such nurseries shipped trees in 1963 with total shipments of 185,615,000 trees as against shipments of 181,182,000 trees in 1962 from 29 nurseries.

Commercial nurseries shipping stock in 1963 numbered 95 and their total output was 64,761,000 plants, which is about 5 million less than in 1962.

Of the 95 commercial nurseries that reported, 24 are in Pennsylvania and 25 are in Michigan. Their production runs heavily to Christmas tree planting stock. Twelve commercial nurseries reported from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Nebraska, and the two Dakotas. They produce mainly windbarrier species in addition to much ornamental stock not reported herein. A large share of their production is sold to the States for distribution under the Federal-State cooperative tree planting program. The other 34 commercial nurseries are located in 14 States distributed from coast to coast, primarily in the North. No commercial production of forest or windbarrier planting stock is reported from 28 States and Puerto Rico. Direct Seeding
