Scope of Eligibility: Open to applicants who meet the requirements below.

Description: Under the supervision of a Regional Forester or other supervisory official in the Department of Environmental Protection, assists in the implementation of forestry programs on state, municipal, and private lands; provides professional forestry review, planning, and recommendations for forestry programs within an assigned region or central office; does other related duties as required.

Specific to the Position:

State Lands/Forest Health:

Duties include assisting in the implementation of forestry programs across state, municipal, and private lands. Trainees participate in forest reconnaissance, forest product sales, data acquisition, analysis, forest health monitoring (insect and disease trapping and detection) and assistance with forest entomology and pathology. This role provides valuable experience in forestry, natural resource management, and environmental protection, contributing to sustainable forest management practices and enhancing New Jersey's natural resources.

State Tree Nursery:

Duties include assisting in the implementation of forestry programs across state, municipal, and private lands. Trainees participate in the operation of the state tree nursery including seed collection, tree and shrub propagation, maintenance, harvest, sale, and distribution of planting stock. This role provides valuable experience in forestry, natural resource management, and environmental protection, contributing to sustainable forest management practices and enhancing New Jersey's natural resources.

Preferred Skill Set: Strong organizational and communication skills. Knowledge of traditional forestry tools, GPS, spatial software/analysis, and ability to develop and interpret technical reports.

Requirements

EDUCATION:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree or higher in Forestry, Natural Resource Management, Urban Forest Management, Silviculture, Forest Biometrics, or other closely related Forestry curriculum.

NOTE: All U.S. degrees and transcripts must be from an accredited college or university. All foreign degrees and transcripts must be evaluated for accreditation by a recognized evaluation service by the closing date of this posting. Failure to provide documentation may result in ineligibility.

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

Residency: All persons newly hired on or after September 1, 2011 have one year from the date of employment to establish, and then maintain principal residence in the State of New Jersey subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 (L.2011, Chapter 70), also known as the "New Jersey First Act".
